## SENIORS

**There is a new Sept. ACT being offered, however all registrations date are past, and standby status only is available. You must register BY PAPER METHOD, so please come to guidance for a packet.**

**Today, September 10<sup>th</sup>**, is the deadline for registering for the October 6 **SAT**. You may still register, with a late fee, up to Sept. 14<sup>th</sup>. Some out of state colleges prefer the SAT instead of the ACT. Check the school's website to see which test they prefer. On line registration is recommended, however limited packets are available in the guidance office.

## Michigan Merit Exam

(MME) results will be distributed to seniors during their class meeting. Vouchers for those who need to re-take the MME will be given out. These vouchers are valid for students who did not pass and who plan to take the **OCTOBER ACT**. More details to be forthcoming!!

## COLLEGE REPS

Throughout the fall, a number of college representatives will visit Regina. Juniors and seniors are permitted to visit **three** representatives, however students **MUST** sign up before 5<sup>th</sup> hour one day prior to the college rep's visit. The sign up binder is in the Guidance Office in the
