

ATTENTION JUNIOR PARENTS: an important update for the **CLASS OF 2013**

On **Tuesday, March 6, Wednesday, March 7, and Thursday, March 8**, juniors will take the **Michigan Merit Exam (MME)**, which includes the **ACT** test as well as other assessments. We have continued to offer this at Regina (even though the Michigan Promise Scholarship has been discontinued) as a courtesy to our families, since the state of Michigan pays for this initial ACT test. We believe our students benefit from taking this test in the comfortable environs of their home school. However, they will still have the opportunity to re-test on subsequent national test dates held on Saturdays.

- **A mandatory pre-test/registration session will take place on Thursday, February 23.** Juniors must be present in the cafeteria for the entire 6th and 7th hours that day. If a student has not completed this registration, she will not be able to test on March 6, 7 and 8.
- **It is of utmost importance that students make every effort to be in school on all three (3) days of testing on March 6, 7, and 8.** Please do not make or allow your daughter to make appointments or travel plans that would preclude her from being in school on those days. Students must complete the entire cycle of tests.

An ACT Workshop will be held at Regina High School on **Saturday, March 3 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.** Students currently participating in the 7-week ACT class may enroll in the workshop for \$20. The cost for all other students is \$30, and the deadline for registration is February 28. Workshop registration forms are available in the Guidance Office and fees are payable to Regina High School and may be given to Mrs. Labelle in the Spirit Shop, or placed in her mailbox.

A testing schedule and additional information will be available on Regina's website soon. Juniors will be briefed before testing days.
